2020 Hornets' Nest District Webelos-ree Belk Scout Camp

When: Friday November 6th 6 PM – Sunday November 8th 11AM.

Where: Belk Scout Camp, 9408 Belt Road, Midland, NC <http://www.mycampgrimes.org/belk>

Who: All registered Hornets' Nest District Webelos Scouts.

Cost: \$25.00 per Scout, \$20.00 per Leader or Adult.

Registration: Each Pack must submit a registration form listing all Webelos and Adults who will be attending. Registrations and payment should be turned in at the Council Scout office along with medical form A and B for all campers on or before **Friday October 16th, 2020 at 5PM**. All Patrols must have a minimum of two leaders. One of these leaders must be 21 years of age and a registered scout leader. For every 12 scouts registered, the Pack **MUST** provide 2 adults for staffing work during a portion of the Webelos-Ree.

Meals: Each Pack will be responsible for their own meals for the weekend. We are using this approach to reduce the cost of the Webelos-Ree. You should plan for Saturday breakfast, lunch (this should be a bag lunch), dinner and Sunday breakfast. We encourage you to let the boys help with the meal planning prior to camp and as much as possible, do the cooking for the weekend. We suggest planning for 30 minutes of cooking time and 30 minutes to eat for breakfast and 45 minutes of cooking time and 30 minutes to eat for dinner. The boys will be organized in Webelos patrols and Arrow of Light patrols and may be teamed with more than one Pack during the day activities to each station. This is a great opportunity for them to meet new boys from other areas they may not otherwise have a chance to meet. Patrol assignments will be provided prior to camp.

Camping: We will be camping in Cub Scout World and Boy Scout World. Cub Scout World has platform tents available for use, but Scouts are encouraged to bring, setup, and sleep in their own tents with other scouts in preparation for Boy Scouts. If your Pack would prefer to camp in Boy Scout World, you must bring your own tents and indicate this on your registration form. Please keep in mind that Boy Scouts 1-5 and Adirondacks 1&2 are not available this year. Camp site assignments will be provided prior to camp.

Boy Scouts: Boy Scouts who are 14 years of age and are First Class rank are encouraged to volunteer as Camp Staff. All Boy Scouts interested in being part of staff should complete a staff application and email Camp Director Tim Lamb
